Recruitment Tips to consider:

- Utilising automated alerts on eHealth systems such as Charm Health to notify investigators/coordinators of suitable patients.
- Keeping new registrars informed of KEYPAD trial and encouraging screening and identifying patients.
- Cross-referrals and presence of KEYPAD site staff at MDT meetings are vital in raising awareness for study.

KEYPAD Translational Research

- **ANNOUNCEMENT:** Real-time shipping for tissue **BLOCKS (only)** has commenced.
 - Sites have recently been posted 10 courier waybills to the Hunter Cancer Biobank.
 - Commence real-time tissue block shipping immediately (including any patients already on study please).
 - If a block cannot be released, **DON'T** cut slides until advised by KEYPAD coordinating centre.

Data management

Reminder that as per protocol, CT imaging (brain, chest, abdomen and pelvis) is required at baseline, weeks 12, 18, 24, then every 12 weeks until PD. Baseline CT scan must be done within 14 days of registration and 14 days of start of treatment. That is, 28 days window is allowed from scan to treatment.

De-identified CT scan reports at baseline and once disease progression is confirmed are required to be forwarded to KEYPAD@ctc.usyd.edu.au for review. Reports for all other time-points are to be kept in patient file.

AUTO-CHECK Study Update (as at 8 March 2019)

- Trials/cohorts activated **7/7**
- Hospital sites activated **69**
(unique sites: 42)

- Patients participating **194** (64% of the target 300)
- Real-time blood shipments (to Canberra) **316**
- IRAE blood samples collected **26** (13% of patients).
