The Trial Management Committee has recently met and made the decision to set an end date to recruitment for the KEYPAD trial. **The last date of recruitment will be 30th June 2022** and we're asking all our KEYPAD investigators and trials teams to help us come as close to the target as possible over the next couple of months. Currently, 55 participants are enrolled and we're aware of a couple of potential patients across different sites who may be interested and eligible to join the study.
